To make a Will you need to know what money and possessions you have and who is to receive them. You also need to decide who is to administer your Estate. We normally recommend that two people are appointed. To ensure that there is always somebody available you may appoint a partner in this firm.

You should remember that a professionally drafted Will may last you a lifetime and so any cost is well worth it. At Integrum a typical single Will costs £100 plus VAT and a joint Will costs £150 plus VAT. Obviously more complex Wills or Estate planning will cost more. We are also happy to keep your Will in secure storage free of charge, many banks charge for this service.

A Will is a declaration of your intentions to take effect upon your death. Wills decide who gets what and who controls your affairs. A Will can avoid many unpleasant and expensive disputes after your death especially over your children, your home and your belongings.

A Will allows you to provide for unmarried partners who would not normally benefit without a Will. It also allows you to make arrangements for your children as well as making gifts of personal effects and specifying burial arrangements. Wills can also be used to avoid or reduce taxes on death. Where married couples are separated but not divorced a Will would ensure that one spouse does not benefit from the death of the other.
